DESCRIPTION

This course explores the intersection of human, animal, and environmental health and facilitates the understanding of health as an inexorably linked system requiring multidisciplinary collaborative efforts. The **One Health** concept demonstrates the importance of a holistic approach to disease prevention and the maintenance of human, animal, and environmental health. Co-listed at Duke and UNC to promote cross-campus and cross-discipline interactions, this discussion-based seminar course is taught through a mix of guest lectures by experts in One Health and global health, panel discussions, and collaborative case studies. Graduate and professional students from any discipline interested in interconnected health challenges are encouraged to enroll.
