ELIGIBILITY

- **Interactive Seminars**: Participate in seminars with faculty, field experts, and graduate students. Explore diverse topics through engaging discussions as part of a collaborative cohort.
- **Experiential Learning:** Engage in hands-on projects and leadership activities that enhance your practical skills and interdisciplinary understanding.
- Study Abroad: Attend a transformative course in the Czech Republic during Summer II 2025. Address global challenges like the health impacts of climate change, emerging infectious diseases, and antimicrobial resistance. Scholars will receive funding to cover the costs.
