DESCRIPTION


This course is designed to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of Global One Health, emphasizing the interconnectedness of **human, animal, plant, and environmental health**. Students will engage with critical topics like emerging **infectious diseases**, sustainable **food and water** sources, and the intertwined issues of **climate change** and related **health disparities**, using interdisciplinary approaches to tackle real-world challenges.

The course will equip students with the foundational knowledge and skills to apply a **One Health** approach, utilizing systems thinking and interdisciplinary perspectives to address and manage health challenges at the global level.
