DESCRIPTION

Global One Health Applications provides a comprehensive examination of key One Health issues through an interdisciplinary lens. The course delves into topics which may include **antimicrobial resistance**, emerging **zoonotic diseases**, **climate change** and **vector-borne** diseases, and the health impacts of **environmental pollution**. Topics are explored through intensive **case studies**, emphasizing collaborative analysis and problem-solving. The course culminates with students creating and presenting their own case studies, integrating interdisciplinary approaches learned throughout the course. This course is offered in the Spring semester, and as a **study abroad course in Prague** during Summer II.
