



Faculty excellence is at the core of our university's mission. For many years, NC State has honored faculty through a variety of awards and recognitions. I am requesting your leadership to initiate and guide the process of nominating faculty to be honored for the 2023-24 academic year. Specific timelines, criteria, forms, selection processes and recognition for awards managed by the Office for Faculty Excellence are available via go.ncsu.edu/internal-faculty-awards. **Please review the website each year for any updates to requirements and procedures.**

Deans should establish one or more faculty award nomination committees charged to solicit and accept nominations, assure preparation of nomination materials and submit materials for the appropriate teaching or faculty award by the stated deadlines.

- Board of Governors Award for Excellence in Teaching - **Wednesday, October 11, 2023**
- Provost's Award for Excellence in Teaching - **Wednesday, October 25, 2023**
- Alexander Quarles Holladay Medal for Excellence - **Wednesday, November 15, 2023**
- Outstanding Teacher Award - **Wednesday, November 29, 2023**

- Alumni Distinguished Undergraduate Professor Award - **Wednesday, December 6, 2023**

Submission Procedures

- Submit nomination materials to Sherry Bailey, internal faculty awards coordinator and faculty affairs support specialist, at sbbailey@ncsu.edu as email attachments or upload them to Google Drive.
- Create one pdf file for each component of the nomination package and submit all pdf files that comprise each nomination package at the same time.

Please note that the names of award nominees and recipients are **confidential** until officially announced to the campus by the Provost's Office. Activities of the selection committees are also confidential.
