SUBJECT:	2023-24 University Faculty Scholars Program

The University Faculty Scholars Program was established in 2012 by Chancellor Woodson to recognize and reward emerging academic leaders among our tenured and tenure-track faculty. I am pleased to announce that the program is continuing for the 2023-24 academic year. We will identify approximately twenty tenured or tenure-track faculty scholars who will receive a permanent five percent increase to their base salary and will carry the title University Faculty Scholar for the duration of their faculty appointment at NC State.

The nomination process remains the same. Nominations are limited to assistant professors who have been re-appointed for a second term, all associate professors, and professors within the first three years of appointment at that rank. Faculty members who were nominated but not named University Faculty Scholars in previous years and still meet eligibility requirements may be re-nominated by their college. No faculty member may receive the award more than once.

The maximum number of nominations that each college may submit is listed in the following table. The number of nominations is based on the number of tenured and tenure-track faculty FTEs in that college. No college will receive a predetermined number of awards in any year.
