1 Headcount Enrollment - primary majors only

Primary enrollment in each degree program/plan and associated subplans as measured at census (tenth day of class) of fall semester

2 Headcount Enrollment - multiple majors included

Primary enrollment plus second major enrollments in plan and subplans as measured at census (tenth day of class) of fall semester

3 Demand – new freshmen

Number of applications submitted for admission to the program in the fall semester

4 Demand – new transfers

Number of applications submitted for admission to the program in the fall semester

5 Intra-campus transfers into degree program

Number of students in the program who were in a different program the prior fall.

In COE, the undesignated freshmen within a degree program do not count as an intra-campus transfer when they matriculate in the same degree program (14CEU -> 14CEBS is not a transfer). Also in COE, BE, TE, and PSE students do not count as a transfer in or out when they matriculate from COE undesignated to the other college. FYC, Transition Program, and undesignated programs housed in a Dean's Office are counted as transfers out upon matriculation and are counted at the destination as a transfer in.

6 Intra-campus transfers out of degree program

Number of students who were in this program the prior fall and are now in a different program. A student who graduates, is suspended, or withdraws from the university is not a transfer out in this measure.

In COE, the undesignated freshmen within a degree program do not count as an intra-campus transfer when they matriculate in the same degree program (14CEU -> 14CEBS is not a transfer). Also in COE, BE, TE, and PSE students do not count as a transfer in or out when they matriculate from COE undesignated to the other college.
